## **What Should We Do With Our Building?**

A new short guide has been produced to help churches to think about the future of their building. It provides an overview of options for keeping a building open and information about how Methodists can worship together as a church without a building. It signposts to resources on the website and to people in the connexion and TMCP who can advise on options. The earlier a church thinks about the future, the more options that are open to them, particularly if they want to keep their building open. The leaflet is attached.

## **Church Gardens**

Could your church garden be a missional space? This week the Methodist Church are heading to RHS Flower Show Tatton Park with our garden 'This Garden Isn't Finished Without You' - an exciting opportunity to express our commitment to sustainability, inclusion and diversity in a creative way. No matter what space you have, church gardens can be missional spaces - from a planter pushed against the church wall or a large plot. Our top tips for using church gardens as missional spaces: 1. Include scented flowers and herbs and those with interesting textures, invite people to use the garden as a mindfulness space; 2. Welcome people to a weekly session where together you look after the garden – weeding, watering, planting and so on – this benefits wellbeing and creates community; 3. Grow veg, harvest it and invite people to a meal at which you cook and serve it; 4. Grow bee-loving plants and include habitats for insects; place labels around the garden with environmental information. Invite local schools/uniformed organisations to come along for outdoor learning; 5. Use the space to tell Bible stories by placing little models around the garden for people to discover, with very simple labels.
